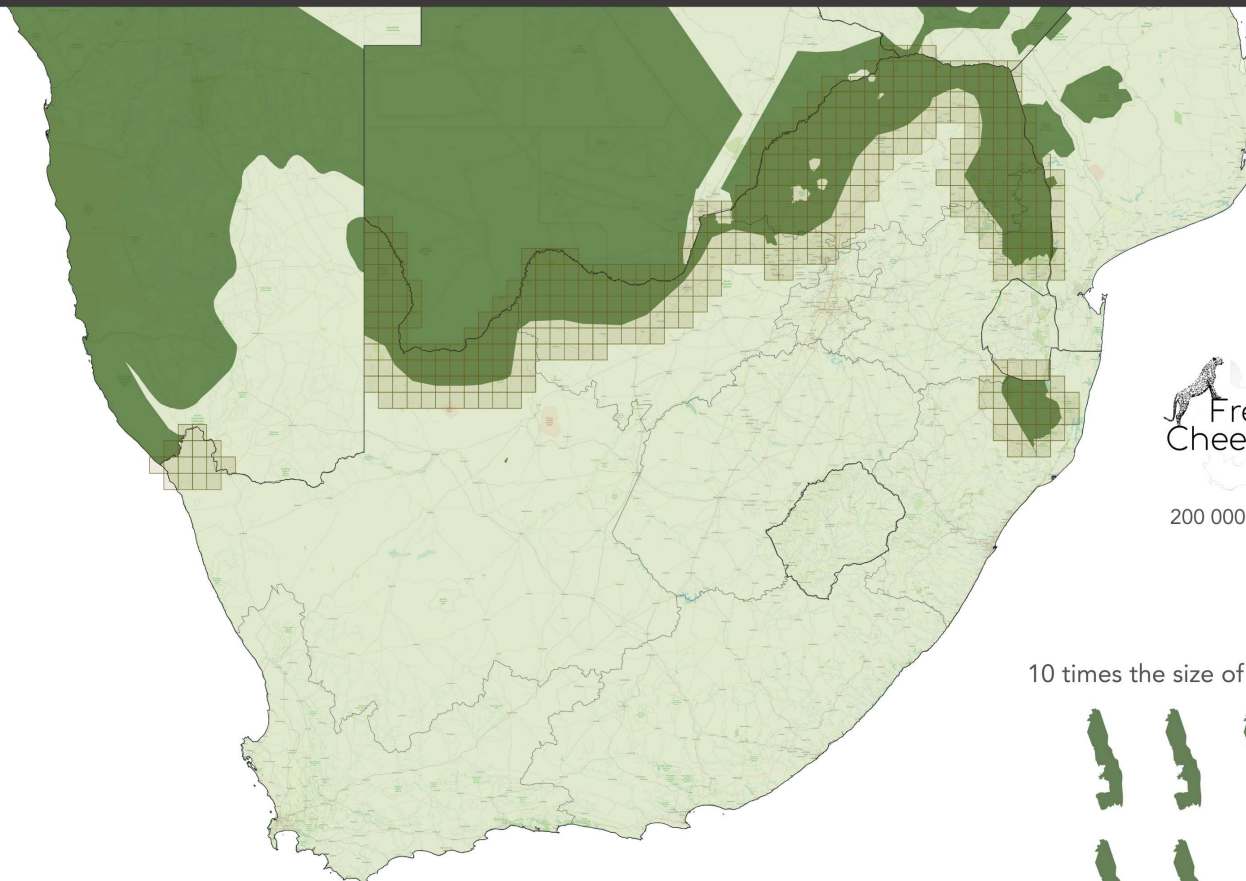




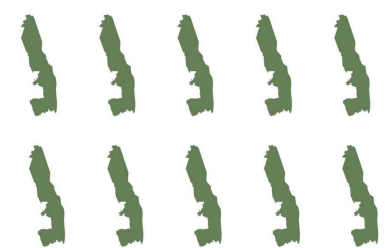
Free-Roaming Cheetah Census

With the use of camera traps selectively placed at cheetah communication hubs (otherwise known as scent-marking trees) and questionnaires answered by farmers and landowners within the marked study area, we aim for a more accurate number of free-roaming cheetah that still remain within South Africa's borders.
